**ANYONE WHO HAS TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID IN THE LAST 7 DAYS OR HAS COVID SYMPTOMS IS RESPECTFULLY ASKED NOT TO ATTEND THE MEETING.**

To comply with the latest Government guidelines regarding Covid-19 restrictions, the following measures must be adhered to:

- Hand sanitiser will be provided and must be used upon entry to and exit from the building.
